What a contrast this year is compared to the last two years, but it's such a great relief to have a season open up with a wonderful rain in March, and to continue so well, providing us all with a great abundance of feed.

Our rams this year are showing what they can really achieve with a good season and put bluntly, with a belly full of good feed!

Following our Stockscan scanning test in late July, on both breeds, the results are the best we have ever seen.

With the Poll Rams, they have tested up to 46mm eye muscle and an average of 40mm over the draft.

These figures, according to our assessor are exceptional, and are accompanied with a rise of 25% in average body weight, together with a very stylish wool.

These rams are really a true dual purpose sheep!

The White Suffolks are really ‘jumping out of their skins’ with figures to match their growth rates, up more than 30% in body weight, and with eye muscle readings up to 52mm. These figures easily match show rams that other studs have with shedded rams on hard feed and concentrates for months on end.

We believe these Stockscan figures are very valuable in our breeding programme, and has given Paul the confidence to accept the position of Australian President of Stockscan Services.

This year we have increased our sale numbers in both breeds to give our clients a larger selection.
