Our May shearing wool tests returned very pleasing results, with the rams averaging 19.1 micron. In addition Stockscan testing in July were extremely encouraging across both breeds, highlighting the depth and balance of our current genetics and quality within our breeding.

In the last 12 months we have continued to strengthen both our breeding programs through strategic ram purchases. These include a very meaty Baringa sire and two very well balanced Anden rams to our White Suffolk stud. Most recently, we were thrilled to secure 240141, the top priced ram at this years Glenlea Park ram sale.
